MONTHLY MUSTER CALL & REPORTING

MUSTER RECOGNITIONS & AWARDS

Pursuant to Union Army Standing Orders, a monthly muster will be conducted of all assigned AotP field army personnel, as follows:

Division Commanders (DC) will issue a muster call on or about the 1st of each month, to all divisional officers. The call will be via e-mail and by means of a post in the Gettysburg Arms. DC's posts in the Gettysburg Arms may include a report on their own current battlefield activity (see below).

- Individual Officers are required to answer the call to muster by the 15th of the month, via either a reply to the muster e-mail or a reply to the DC's Gettysburg Arms post. An officer's muster response will at a minimum indicate their presence, but may also include a report – however brief or extensive – on their current gaming activity.
- DCs will submit a divisional muster report via e-mail to their respective Corps Commander (CC) by the 20th of the month, identifying all division officers answering the call. Submission of a DC's report will also constitute their own individual muster for the month.
- CCs will submit their reports to the Army Commander (or Chief of Staff, as directed) by the 25th of the month. CCs reports will identify all officers mustering, by division, as well as any discretionary bonus awards for 100% Qtrly Muster via Gettysburg Arms posts, and any General Officer promotions earned and Field Promotions occurring in the past month. Submission of their report will also constitute the CC's own individual muster for the month.
- The Army Commander will issue a detailed, comprehensive monthly report to Union Army Headquarters no later than the 15th of the following month, covering the AotP's muster & strength, OOB changes, promotions, battlefield activity, ribbons & recognitions earned, and OBD points awarded, and other such information that may be required or requested by HQ.
